In the Back up documentation I have placed the Councilman Carson's request of a Visitior Center Liason Job Discription and we are happy to announce that we have interviewed a candidate that can provide weekend hours to greet visitors in this location seven days a week.

We wrote a support leter for the NNRY and City of Ely to Administrator Rose of the Federal Railroad Administration in favor of the Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvements ("CRISI") program grant application for the Nevada Northern Railway Track Rehabilitation for Freight Traffic.

County wide economic report for last month, unemployment did go up 0.2% but White Pine still maintains lowest levels of unemployment in the state.

Downtown Ely Visitor Center Plan

OVERVIEW:

- Local visitor's centers are co-located within local chambers of commerce in most communities in the State of Nevada and across the United States.
- These visitor's centers are funded by transient lodging tax, not the local chambers of Commerce.
- The high traffic, main street visibility, and the long-established tendency for visitors to stop at the WP Chamber of Commerce for local information was the reason an official visitor center was established at the Chamber office about 5 years ago.
- Sincer the withdrawal of support of that visitor center in December of last year, the WP Chamber of Commerce has continued to operating a visitor center as staffing and funding has allowed. This has included partnering with AARP to provide funding for wages for a part time employee to staff said visitor center.
- WP Chamber of Commerce is seeking funding from the City of Ely to be able to hire additional people specifically to staff the visitor center. The goal being to eventually secure enough funding to enable the visitor center return to being open and available to the traveling public 7 days a week.
- The funding being requested will not be used for the operation of the WP Chamber of Commerce or to pay the salary of any Chamber executive. Funding will only be used to pay for staff to operate a visitor center.
- Whether or not a supported visitor center is located at the WP Chamber of Commerce, visitors to our community will continue to stop at the Chamber for local information. Funding support staff to interface with out of area visitors allows the Chamber to continue its primary mission of supporting the member businesses contributing to the city and county's enhanced quality of life.
- As a US Chamber of Commerce affiliated Chamber, our Charter complies with their definition of the organization operating as a voluntary partnership of businesses and professionals working together to build a healthy economy and improve the quality of life in a community. As a chamber works to accomplish these goals, it must champion many different functions: economic developer and planner, tourist information center, business spokesperson, economic counselor and teacher, government relations specialist, human resources adviser, and public relations practitioner.

Downtown Ely Visitor Center Liason Position Description

PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- The primary role of the Visitor Centr Liason is to greet, welcome and inform out-of-area visitors that are utilizing the Chamber of Commerce office to obtain information about local amenities, attractison, events, lodging, dining options, and features of interest, in order to entice longer recreational stays in Ely and White Pine County.
- Seek to be a Local Expert, knowledgable in entertainment, recreation, amenities, and business.
- Corrospond via electronic or postal mail in response to remote inquiries, supplying requested information in a timely manner.
- Investigate, learn, and maintain a current knowledge of events, attractions, weather conditions, and opportunities for travelers to take advantage of while in our area.
- Maintain the informational literature, brochures, handouts, rack cards, and current provisional materials to assist visitors in navigating the areas and supplying these along with personalized and friendly insights related to their journey.
- Interface with othr visitors centers along Highway 50, information suppliers, State agencies, Tourism Departments, non-profit organizations, and other communities to ensure useful information is kept up to date and shared through our office and its affiliated websites and social media accounts.
- Ensure a clean and welcoming Visitor Center that provides a warm and friendly experience that is non-partisan, non-sectarian, and reflects the community's openness and eagerness to accommodate visitors and new business.
- Provide the Chamber of Commerce supplemental supports in office related tasks as needed.
- Compile and supply a monthly Visitation report detailing origin of visitor, reason for visit or ultimate destination as well as number of visitors for an approximate estimate of out-of-area traffic.
- Maintain public sidewalk informational boards with up-to-date promotional materials.

INTERPERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS:

• Daily interactions with visitors, Board of Directors, committee members, area businesses, owners, prospective vendors, contractors, and volunteers.

KNOWLEDGE:

- Posess and develop sound knowledge of local tourist attractions and facilities and be aware of activities across the Eastern Nevada / Great Basin region.
- Ability to be a good team member and able to work independently Office Suite, Google Suite, social media, etc.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- 20 hours per week. Flexible hours possible.
- Requires some weekends, holidays and occasional evenings.
