Monthly Operations Report for June 2024

1. Locomotive Status – Updated
 - a. Locomotives in service: #93, #109, 204, 310, 801, Wrecking Crane A & Rotary B.
 - b. Locomotive 81 is out-of-service with running gear and boiler issues. The staff and volunteers have done incredible work on Locomotive 81. The Federal Railroad Administration was here and passed all of the boiler repairs.
 - c. Locomotive 40 is out of service for her heavy repairs. We have started on her repairs; she will be out of service until 2025.
 - d. Locomotives out of service needing moderate repairs: #201 and #802
 - e. Locomotives waiting funding for restoration: Steptoe Valley Smelting and Mining #309 and Rotary Snowplow B (for boiler overhaul.)
 - f. Locomotives out of service needing heavy repairs #80 and the military locomotives.
3. Rolling Stock Status – No change
 - a. Passenger equipment in service: #08, #09, Flatcar #23, Baggage/RPO #20, Outfit Car #06.
 - b. Passenger car #07 is out of service with truck issues. Coach 5 in for painting.
 - c. Passenger equipment out of service: #10, #2 and #05 needing heavy repairs.
 - d. Caboose in service: #3 and #22 are operational.
 - e. Caboose out service: #5 and #6. Caboose #6 needs a 50-year waiver.
4. Track Status – No change
 - a. Keystone Branch is open.
 - b. Adverse Branch is open.
 - c. Museum Branch is open.
5. Ridership and Ticket Sales – Updated
 - a. In June, we carried 2,007 passengers, this was a decrease of 12% compared to the previous year.
 - b. This year to date we have carried 4659 passengers, this was a decrease of 19% compared to the previous year.
 - c. Since operations began in 1987, we have carried 367,358 passengers.
6. Economic Impact – The average non-gaming & gaming daily expenditure per overnight visitor \$170.
Economic impact for June 2024 was $2,007 \times 80\% \times 170 = \$272,952$.
Economic impact year to date was $4659 \times 80\% \times 170 = \$633,624$

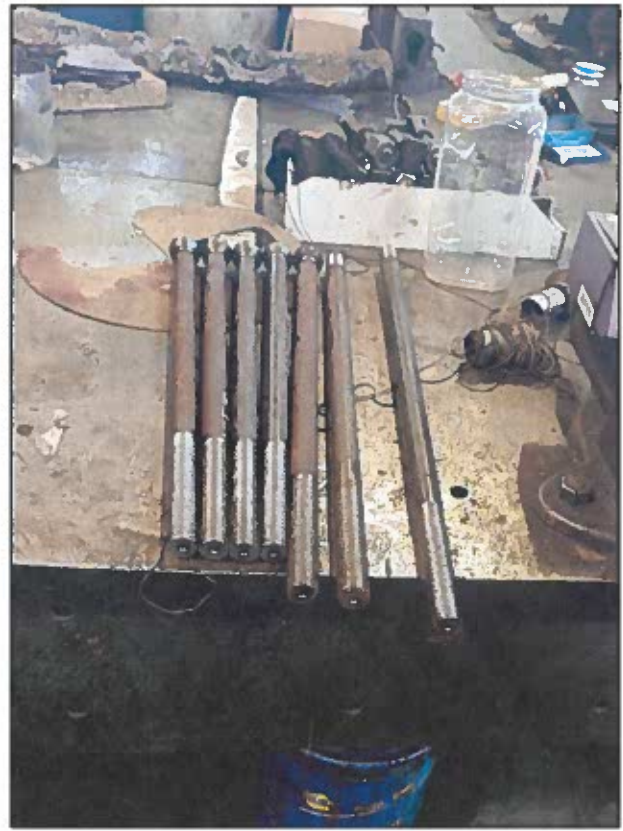

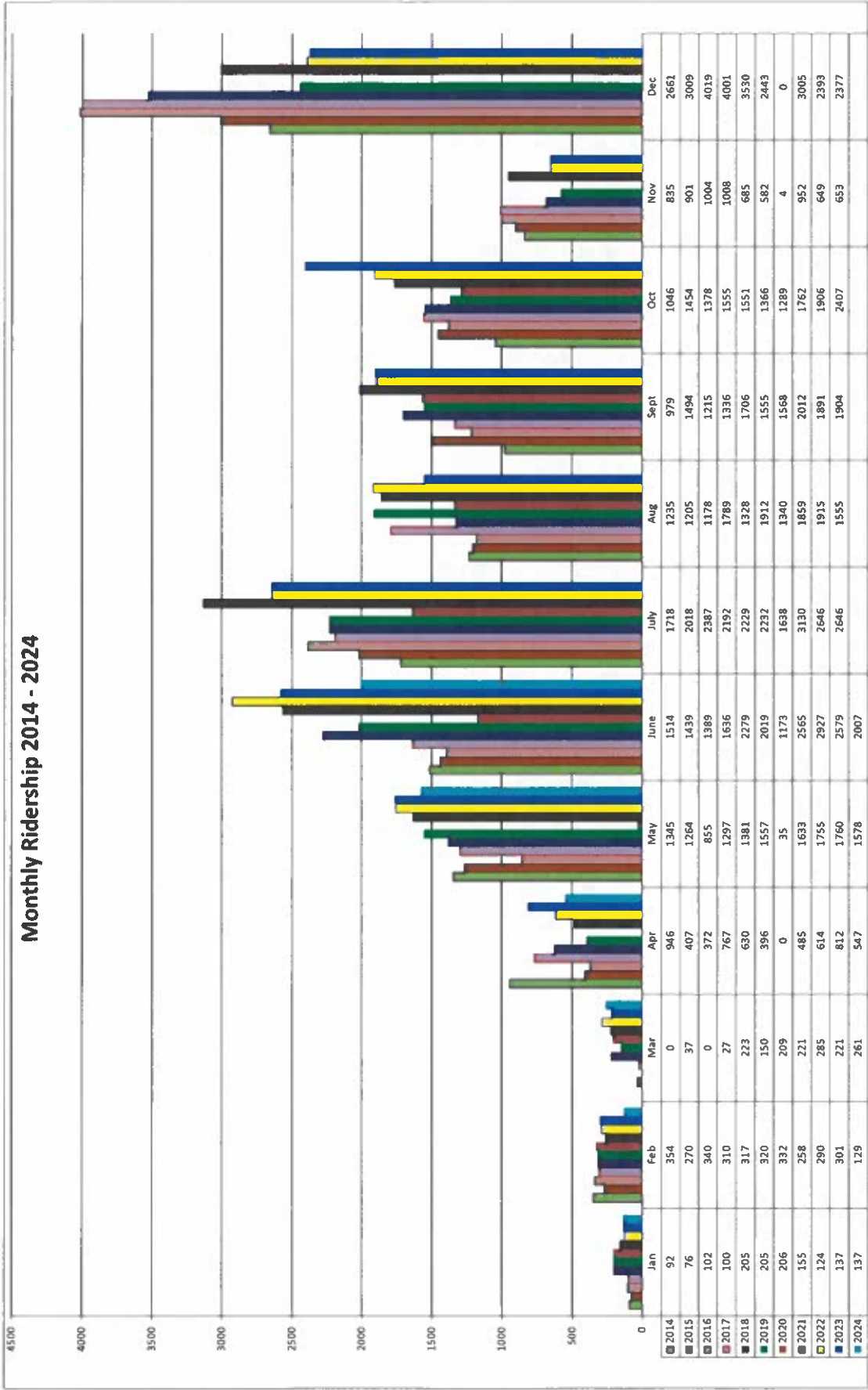

Monthly Ridership 2014 - 2024

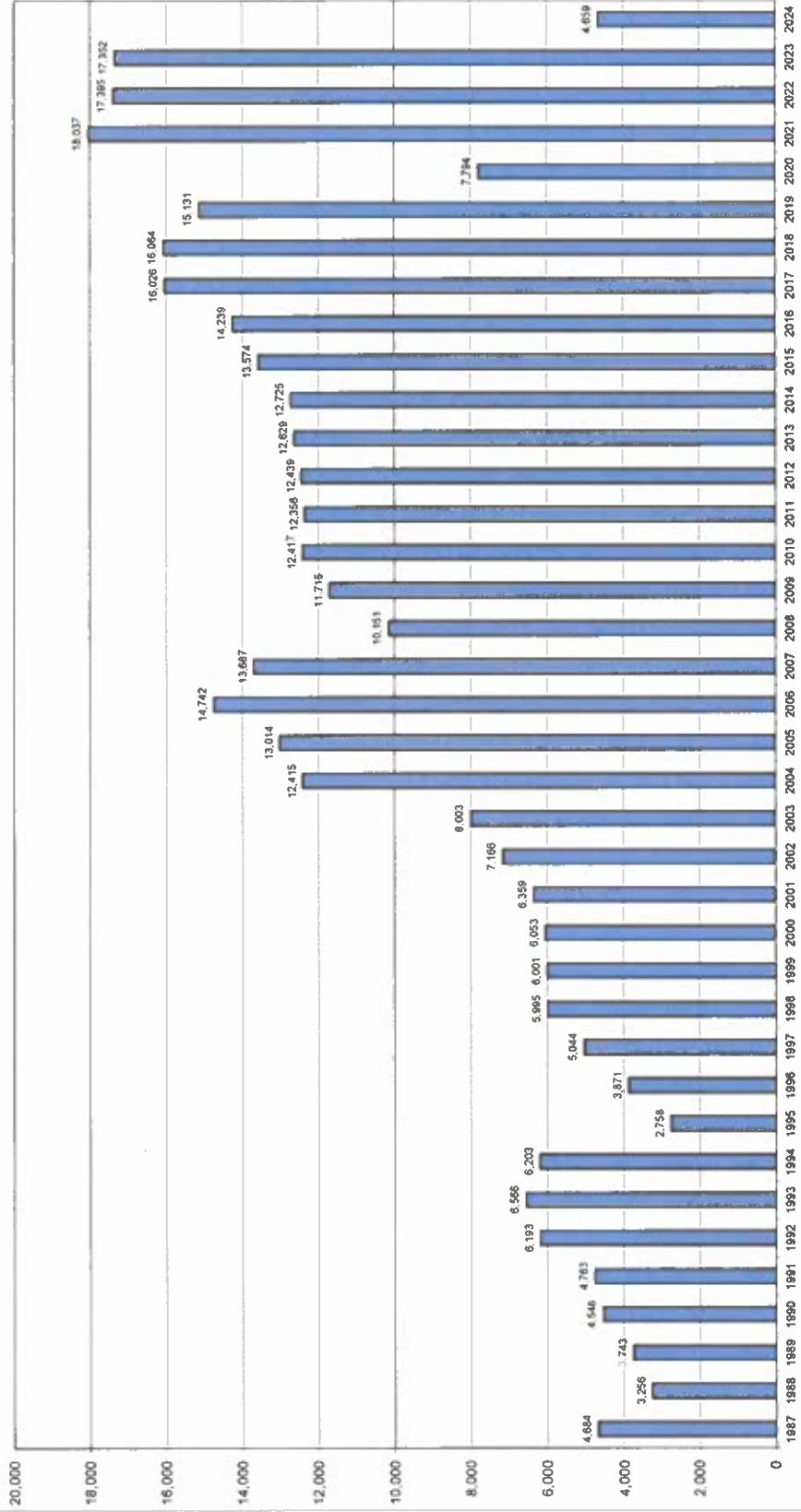


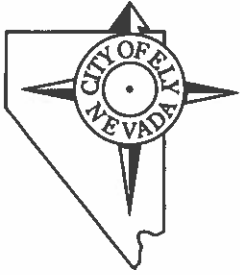

Subject: Monthly Report June 2024

Public Works:

- Everything is running smoothly in all departments (see below).
- Monitoring Duck Pond water usage. Working with County Maintenance Dept. we have come to a temporary solution to reduce water usage.
 - Water usage for the month of June was 200,000 gallons, which was down 10,606 from previous month
- Water usage at the Golf Course irrigation for the month of June was 11,123,000 gallons, which was down about 1,000,000 gallons from the previous month.
- In the process of hiring seasonal employees

Parks/Cemetery

- General maintenance (mowing, trimming, fertilizing) will continue.
- New Utility Truck for the department has been ordered and delivery is unknown at this time.
- Department staff has been busy keeping up with Broadbent Park maintenance with the 4th of July activities and upcoming concert series.
- Fully staffed.

Water/Sewer

- The Water / Sewer Depts. Dump truck was picked up in Reno on June 28th and is in operation.
- The process is still ongoing with replacing older hydrants with new ones.
- Cleanup will continue.

The City of Ely is an equal opportunity provider and employer.

- Pierson Brothers Construction was awarded the new building. The building has been ordered and the sitework has begun.
- Fully staffed.

WWTP

- Continuing training with Raul Naranjo is a continued process.
- Cleanup will continue
- Fully Staffed.

Streets

- Continued work with the County's Street department
- Looking at purchasing a dump truck for the Street Department through the County towards the later part of July or first part of August after the County makes their transition to their newly purchased trucks. If a truck is purchased, the plow will need fabrication to fit the purchased truck.
- Vacuum hose on newly purchased street sweeper broke and is being repaired by a qualified technician in Salt Lake City and should be completed and back in service by mid-July.
- Street Sweeping as required
- Durapatching and Crack sealing will be done throughout the summer.
- Summer street projects are continuing as planned.
- Fully staffed.

Animal Control


- Animal Control truck ordered and delivery is unknown at this time.
- Continued work with City, County, and Law Enforcement

Landfill

- We're looking to secure two dump trucks in later July or early August through the County.
- The compactors transmission has been removed and transported to Salt Lake City and should be completed mid-August if parts arrive as scheduled with no delays.
- The Landfill loader is getting new tires with foam in them and should be completed mid-July.
- There are fourteen (14) bales of Aluminum and will sell when price dictates.
- Fully staffed.
