The Hazardous Materials class was conducted throughout the month of February. The class started with four students. Two from Robinsons mine rescue team and two from McGill Volunteer Fire Department. This class included 24hrs of in person class sessions along with a month-long online program. Three students were able to take the Nevada State Fire Hazardous materials Awareness and Operations test. Results are still to be posted.
